- Monitor and sustain timely maintenance and calibration of laboratory equipment to ensure optimum performance and minimum downtime
- Assist in the creation of processes to streamline workflows within the labs
- Work closely with the Warehouse Specialist to guarantee timely receiving of all deliveries

- Minimal local travel in connection with the performance of your duties
